## **NRD Monitoring Salt Creek Levee**

LINCOLN (NE) May 7, 2015 – The Lower Platte South Natural Resources District has mobilized teams to monitor operation of Lincoln’s Salt Creek Levee. Several inches of rainfall throughout the watershed in the last 24 hours have raised water levels in the creek to near flood stages. NRD General Manager Glenn Johnson said, “The levee system is functioning as it should and the NRD will continue to monitor Salt Creek through Lincoln.” Water that has accumulated in many places behind the levee cannot be drained until water levels in the creek lower, so standing water on or near the dry side of the Salt Creek Levee at this time is to be expected.

The NRD is asking the public to stay off of the levee for their own safety and to allow emergency personnel to more safely monitor the levee.
